Board of Fire Commissioners Regular Meeting

Call to Order: Chairman Taft called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Attendees: Chairman Taft, Commissioner Safford, Commissioner Johnson, Chief Schmidt, Battalion Chief Nunemaker, Executive Assistant Linklater, 2 crew members, and 2 citizens. Finance Director Perez was absent.

Flag Salute: Led by Commissioner Safford

Consent Agenda:

- 1) Approval of Minutes from April 21st, 2026, Regular Meeting

Commissioner Safford made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda items 1 through 3. Chairman Taft seconded; Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Financial Report: The Financial Report was provided to the Commissioners. No discussion occurred.

Old Business:

Station 49 Roof Replacement – Discussion was held regarding the three bids received for the Station 49 Roof Replacement project. After careful consideration of the bids, the Commissioners conducted a vote.

Commissioner Safford made a motion to approve S&S Roofing LLC to replace the roof at Station 49. Commissioner Johnson seconded; Motion carried by unanimous vote.

New Business:

Tender Engine Decommission –

Commissioner Safford made a motion to approve the removal of the 2004 Kenworth Tender from being a frontline emergency vehicle once the 2026 Spartan Tender Engine is in service. Chairman Taft seconded; Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Resolution 2026-02 Use of District Credit Card – Following the resignation of Commissioner Nordstrom, his district credit card was deactivated. Commissioner Safford will be added as an authorized user on the District's credit card account.

Chairman Taft made a motion to approve Resolution 2026-02 Use of District Credit Card, adding Dave Safford as a card user and removing Commissioner Nordstrom. Commissioner Johnson seconded; Motion carried by unanimous vote.

District Policies Reformation – Administration reformatted the District's policies for consistency. No changes were made to the content of the policies.

Commissioner Safford made a motion to approve the reformatted district policies. Chairman Taft seconded; Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Liz Loomis – Chief Schmidt expressed his recommendation that the District engage Liz Loomis to assist with the EMS Levy planned for 2027 and the Regular Levy planned for 2028. Ms. Loomis has extensive experience managing levy campaigns and maintains a 93% approval rating. Chief Schmidt will arrange a meeting between Ms. Loomis and the Commissioners during the 2026 WFOA Spring Conference in Chelan next week, where she is scheduled to speak.

- Apparatus Report – New Tender Engine arrived. Will be going back to True North for some improvements. Once the TE returns to the District, a Ceremony will be scheduled before it is in service.

- Lon Langdon Memorial Plaque – Commissioner Johnson is working on having it remade.

FF Hayman has been taking initiative on many large projects and seeing them through completion. A Citizen recognized Executive Assistant Linklater for her assistance on a records request. Commissioner Reports –

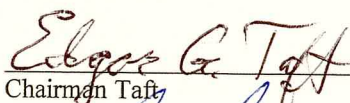

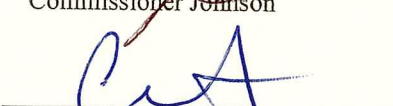
Adjournment: There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
